The Office of Legal Affairs of the United Nations presents its compliments to the Permanent Missions to the United Nations and has the honour to announce the advertisement of Job Opening No. 17-LEG-OLA-76463-D-NEW YORK (G) for the position of Director (D-2) in the General Legal Division, Office of Legal Affairs.

The Office of Legal Affairs is the central legal service of the Organization and provides legal advice to the Secretary-General, Secretariat departments and offices and United Nations organs in the field of public and private law; represents the Secretary-General in legal conferences and in judicial proceedings; performs substantive and secretariat functions for legal organs involved in public international law, the law of the sea and international trade law; and performs the functions conferred on the Secretary-General in Article 102 of the Charter of the United Nations.

The core functions of the General Legal Division are outlined in detail in Section 7 of the Secretary-General's bulletin on the Organization of the Office of Legal Affairs (ST/SGB/2008/13).

In order to ensure a sufficiently broad and representative pool of candidates, to attract the best qualified candidates and to supplement the Secretariat's search, the Secretariat would be grateful if Permanent Missions could circulate the vacancy announcement to suitable candidates so that they may submit their applications. The Secretariat would especially welcome applications from women candidates.

Applications should be submitted through the United Nations online recruitment platform, which is accessible at careers.un.org. Applicants are urged to carefully follow all instructions available in the online recruitment platform. For more detailed guidance, applicants may refer to the "Application Process" link and The Applicant's Manual - Instructional Manual for the Applicant on the Staff Selection System. All applications must be received by 9 July 2017.

Human Rights Screening

Individuals who seek to serve with the United Nations in any individual capacity will be required, if short listed, to complete a self-attestation stating that they have not committed, been accused of or investigated for, or prosecuted for or convicted of, any criminal offence and have not been involved, by act or omission, in the commission of any violation of international human rights law or international humanitarian law. Individuals who have been investigated for, charged with or prosecuted for any criminal offence but were not convicted will be required to provide information regarding the investigation(s) or prosecutions concerned.

Conflicts of Interest

Short-listed individuals will also be required to complete the pre-appointment declaration of interests for senior positions to identify possible conflicts of interest that may arise and to proactively prevent and manage, as much as possible and in a timely manner, situations in which personal interests may conflict or appear to conflict with the interests of the United Nations, should the individual be appointed to this position.
